obscuring the existence of the German Empire, Christian in its bottom and  
essence, considered and fought for by Russian historical traditions,  
obvious economic and strategic interests and the Man's in my view  
psychology, as object to be attained not by a general upheaval but  
by treaties, like those which the Government under Nicolas II  
had signed in the Far East, or in 1915 with Great Britain for

Our hope to the Canadian public opinion rightly grasped in this affair  
the important point is not in an atom-based next, as a matter

risked her life in order to save a principle, having heroically renounced  
herself for the triumph of the principle of self-determination and spending  
now all her efforts not so much for her own benefit, but for a new  
cause, impossible to be attained with such partners as U.S.S.R.  
And that is the point for which I do waste unceasingly writing and  
encouraged by the authors of some of the most influential world-statesmen,  
it is the most dangerous mission to try to break a law about a wolf, a wolf  
conspiracy in order to prepare a world progressiv situation in the even less  
hidden aims of U.S.S.R. the tyranny of which, camouflaging a false democracy, and  
miserable and miserable not negligible, is 1000 times more pernicious for the oppressed  
Russian People and as a bad example for all mobs of the World (coloured ones  
especially), than that of France over the Vendée, for a matter of fact,
