CTS passed by the GENERAL ASSEM-BLY of the province of NEW-BRUNSWICK, began and held, at the City of SAINT JOHN on the THIRD day of JANUARY, in the year of our LORD, one thousand feven hundred and eighty fix, and in the twenty fixth year of the reign of our fovereign LORD GEORGE the THIRD of Great-Britain, France and Ireland, KING, defender of the faith, &c. and there continued by feveral prorogations until the thirteenth day of February, one thoufand feven hundred and eighty feven, in the twenty feventh year of his faid Majefty's reign, being the fecond feffion of the first House of ASSEMBLY convened in the faid Province.
