CAP. XXXVI.

An Act to regulate Vessels arriving from the United Kingdom with Passengers and Emigrants.

Passed 27th February 1832.

WHEREAS the Practice of landing Passengers and Emigrants from the United Kingdom, who are in a destitute and diseased Condition, has become extremely burthensome, and sometimes dangerous to the Health of the Inhabitants of this Province: And Whereas such Distress and Distress are often occasioned by the Practice of taking on board Ships in the Ports of the United Kingdom more Passengers and Emigrants than can be comfortably accommodated: And Whereas it is just and expedient that the Inhabitants of this Province should be relieved from some of the heavy Burthens thus imposed upon them;’
