CAP. XXXVI.

An Act to regulate Vessels arriving from the United Kingdom with Passengers and Emigrants.

Passed 27th February 1832.

'WHEREAS the Practice of landing Passen'gers and Emigrants from the United Kingdom,
'who are in a destitute and diseased Condition,
'has become extremely burthensome, and some'times dangerous to the Health of the Inhabi'tants of this Province: And Whereas such Dis'ease and Distress are often occasioned by the
'Practice of taking on board Ships in the Ports
'of the United Kingdom more Passengers and
'Emigrants than can be comfortably accommo'dated: And Whereas it is just and expedient
'that the Inhabitants of this Province should be
'relieved from some of the heavy Burthens thus
'imposed upon them;'
