

On motion, *resolved*, that a Committee be appointed to wait on His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, to inform His Excellency, that this House have finished the Public Business of the Session.

*Ordered*, That Mr. Mortimer, Mr. Wells and Mr. Freeman, be a committee for the above purpose.

On motion, *Resolved*, That the Second Volume of Province Laws be delivered to each of the Clerks of the Peace, and each of the Town Clerks, in the respective Counties and Districts of the Province; and also, that the First Volume of the said Laws be furnished to such of the Members as have not already had one.

Mr. Mortimer reported from the Committee appointed to wait on His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, to inform His Excellency that the House had finished the Public Business of the Session, that the Committee had waited on His Excellency, pursuant to the Order of the House, and that His Excellency had been pleased to say, that he would be ready to prorogue the House this Day, at two of the Clock.

A Message from His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, by Mr. Deputy-Secretary Cogswell :

Mr. Speaker,

His Excellency commands this House to attend His Excellency immediately in the Council Chamber.

Accordingly Mr. Speaker with the House went up to attend His Excellency in the Council Chamber, where His Excellency was pleased to give his Assent to the several Bills following, viz.

An Act for the Encouragement of the Cod and Scale Fisheries of the Province.

An Act to empower the Lieutenant-Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being, to appoint Commissioners to Issue Treasury Notes.

An Act in addition to the Acts to prevent the forestalling Cord Wood.

An Act to regulate the payment of the Monies due to the Province for Provisions supplied to the Inhabitants, and to apply the same to the service of Roads and Bridges.

An Act relating to Trespasses.

An Act to amend and continue an Act, passed in the 51st year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act for the better regulation of Solicitors and Proctors practising in the Courts of Law and Equity in this Province.

An Act in addition to and amendment of an Act, passed in the forty-first year of his Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act for the repairing, keeping in repair, cleaning and paving, the Streets in the Town and Peninsula of Halifax, and for removing obstructions therein; and also, to suspend the power and authority vested in the Surveyors of Highways, within the Town and Peninsula of Halifax, after the first day of August next, during the operation of this Act.

An Act to continue an Act, passed in the 52d year of His Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act in further addition to the Act relating to Wills, Legacies, and Executors; and for the settlement and distribution of the Estates of Intestates.

An Act to continue an Act to establish Grammar Schools in several Counties and Districts in this Province; and also the Act, passed in the 54th year of His Majesty's Reign, in amendment thereof.

An Act to continue in force the several Acts therein mentioned.

An Act in addition to, and amendment of, an Act, made in the second year of His present Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act for the appointing of Firewards, ascertaining their duty, and for punishing Thefts and Disorders at the time of Fire.

An Act to extend the Provisions of an Act, passed in the first year of His Majesty's
