### FARMERS' MARKET

TORONTO, Feb. 27. - Inclement weather seriously interfered with business at the local Farmers' Market on Saturday. Offerings were plentiful as farmers got in before the rain commented, but purchases were few. Sellers held out for 35 cents per dozen for strictly new laid eggs, but afterwards let them go at 30 to 33 cents and then there were plenty left over. It was the same with butter. Farmers wanted 35 cents per pound at first but afterwards sold out at 20 to 33c. While there was no great supply of poultry, offerings were sufficient for needs. Prices were about steady. Trade was slow in apples. Vegetables were steady. Beef was unchanged, \$10.50 per hundredweight being asked for hindquarters and \$7.50 for forequarters. Quotations:

TORONTO, Feb. 27. - The outstanding features of trade at the Union Stock Yards yesterday was the sharp advance made in the market values of swine, 25c being added to the already phenomenally high figures.  
Market values of cattle were about steady with the close of last week. Prices of calves were in the market but they were not disposed to pay the prices asked by drovers. Offerings were about 1000 less to-day than a week ago, and this helped to steady the situation. Another bullish factor was that holders, who could not get the price they wanted last week-end, were anxious to get rid of their cattle to Montreal on Friday. The top price paid for butchers' cows was \$6.75 per hundredweight, but cows of the best were held for higher prices. All classes of cattle were represented. Milkers and springers were short. Prices of calves were paid, and while stockers were quoted a shade firmer at \$5 to \$5.60. Choice cows and bulls sold well. \$5.75 being the top price for bulls and \$5.65 for butchers cows. Calves were about steady, \$9.50 being the top price quoted.
