## THE KINDERGARTENS.

To the Ratepayers of Chatham:

One consideration which caused me to take up my residence here, was the liberty I had of giving my children a kindergarten training—the only reasonable method yet found out for young children to get correct ideas necessary to fit them for their future. The great Prussian counsellor Dinter said, "I promised God that I would look upon every Prussian peasant child as a being, who could complain of me, if I do not provide him with the best education as a man and a Christian, which it is possible for me to provide." In the face of this, and after this city has provided such liberties by fitting up splendid accommodations, and have a splendid staff of teachers, we are confronted with a learned parsimoniousness, in our Board of Education, pronouncing these liberties luxurious, trying to curtail its usefulness and numbers by charging fees—as if any fee charged would keep out your child or mine—and lastly, by decreasing the kindergarten staff of instructors. This I know to be false economy. No decrease in any way, except to lower the janitor's salary from \$70 a month to something less, and to dismiss the school during such a small-pox—so-called—scare, as we have lately passed through, could properly lessen expenses. By looking at your tax slip or notification you will see that the High and Public school assessments are together about five mills, which was not high. To those candidates who ran for the Council at the last election, and who spouted against the luxurious schools and their cost, I would ask "What have they done with the rest of the 28 mills?" Please figure out and see if officials pay does not amount to more than the price of the schools, and further, if the Council, as the Water Commissioners declare, have spent their money, too, then figure out whether you pay only 28 mills or 41 1-2 mills, as I did last year, and this without paying for pavement, lawn service, lights or other improvements. Where then should we begin to curtail expenses, so to encourage people to come here, and

so that we can lend money without borrowing it first? The answer is easy. Do away with one assessor, and with all appointments made this year to new offices created for good men left out, and then I think you can see clearly a method of still lessening the official ranks, and also the rate of assessment, and when next election time comes around leave a few councilmen at home, who thought before their election, that the city could be run at from 16 to 24 mills as rate of assessment. Am sorry my letter is so long, but my feelings are such that I wish all interested to know as I do that our so-called economy has been misplaced to a great extent in order to draw a herring across the track.
