FIRST SONATA IN D MINOR
For Organ.

"Organists may be recommended a Sonata in D Minor by Alfred H. Allen. This is an extremely well-written work for one who is evidently an expert organist. In the prelude the composer employs the rarely used seven-four alternating with three-four, tempo. His counterpoint flows naturally and without effort. There is an excellent fugue section in this movement. The Intermezzo is melodious and simple in construction, an Allegretto Scherzando in the middle affording effective contrast. The Finale worthily concludes the Sonata."—Morning Post (London).
"A Sonata in D Minor, by Alfred H. Allen, contains something more than sound workmanship, and the light Scherzo affords excellent contrast to the stately opening movement and the elaborate Finale."—Athenaeum (London).


