

the Mad Mullah Out-Mullahed.

The other day the Star published in

its editorial columns a very interesting article on the "Mad Mullah." We are sure that an article on our own "Mad Mullah" would have been far more appreciated by the public than was that on his prototype. Our own "Mad Mullah" has distinctive characteristics which serve to distinguish him from all the other "Mad Mullahs" who ever existed. Nevertheless, he has also a number of traits which cause him to be considered a very good understudy of the original. Chief amongst these is perhaps his ability to speak about himself in such glowing terms as to cause everybody who hears him to say to his neighbor: "Is he not a very modest man?" S uch is the power of speech as possessed by him. But if c e might dare to criticise a man of such great might, he might perhaps say, (sotto voce, of course) that he probably uses the word "Ego" just a little too often. Of course it is only natural that a manof his great talents should value himself at his true worth, but surely there is no necessity for him to tell the public what it is unlikely to forget. But perhaps the reason is that being a very modest man he wishes let us know everything he does, so that we shall not at any time, laud him for the deeds of others. Yes, that must be the true explanation. Or perhaps, his ego is a mere inadvertence on his part. At least, quite possibly so. Our own "Mad Mullah" has a call to arms just as had the original. But they differ slightly though probably the latter's is not quite so effectual as our Mullah's is. One calls upon men to follow him to turn the infidel from his land. Ours, however, says to the men of his land, "Follow me for I have your money invested in my pro-

jects," and they follow him. At one time our "Mad Mullah" was the friend of the proletariat. That, however, was long ago. Now, he is the boon companion of the grasping merchant who, (so the M.M. used to allege) takes all he can get and gives naught in return. Rumor has it that again, like the original "Mad Mullah," his power is on the wane. He is exerting to the fullest extent, all of his magnificent and domineering personality in an attempt to reconcile his followers to whom he has lately given cause for discontent. He cannot succeed. If one might venture to make a prophecy, within a short time he will be seen at Catalina, the scene of his former triumphs. tearing his scraggy locks and composing an epitaph to some dog on the strength of which he may probably receive the poet laureateship of Newfoundland, and so gain name for himself which would cause come once more into the limelight that he was so fond of.
