CONSERVATIVE RALLY.

AN ENTHUSIASTIC GATHERING AT PRESCOTT.

Prescott, Ont., Oct. 31.—A grand Conservative rally, under the auspices of the Conservative Association of South Grenville, was held in the Opera House here to-day, and was participated in by representatives from all parts of the united counties of Leeds and Grenville. The principal speakers were Sir Charles Tupper, Hon. Geo. E. Foster and Mr. J. P. Whitney, leader of the Ontario Opposition.

The party were met at the C. P. R. station on the arrival of a special train from Ottawa at one o'clock, and escorted to Daniel's Hotel, where luncheon was partaken of by a string procession was headed by the Gananogue band, after which came the carriage containing Sir Chas. Tupper, Messrs. Foster and Whitney and Dr. Reid, the local member, followed by a string of carriages containing many prominent Conservatives.

After the party had dined they repaired to the Opera House, which was packed to the doors, and a mighty cheer went up as the old chief and his followers took their positions on the platform, surrounded by many of the leading political figures of the province. The President, Mr. T. J. Bennett, occupied the chair, and in a few words introduced the local M. P., Dr. Reid, who expressed himself as being glad to see so many of his constituents gathered together to do honor to their chief, Sir Chas. Tupper, and Mr. Whitney and Mr. Foster. It had been his first opportunity to thank the electors for placing him at the head of the poll at the last general election, and after a few complimentary and well-chosen remarks, he retired in favor of the leaders who would follow.

R. L. Joynt, M. P., spoke briefly, followed by Mr. Whitney, who dealt principally on Ontario politics, severely criticising Mr. Ross and the Cabinet shuffle.

Mr. Foster followed in a humorous, and at the same time vigorous, denunciation of the Liberal rule, and received hearty applause.

Sir Charles Tupper came next, and as he came forward the applause was deafening. He dwelt fully on matters of political importance, paying special stress on the Government's action regarding the sending of a Canadian contingent to the Transvaal.

Sir Charles was followed by Mr. Bergeron, of Quebec, who said the French-Canadians were truly loyal to the old flag.

Speeches by several lesser lights brought a most successful and enthusiastic meeting to a close, after hearty cheers for the Queen, Sir Chas. Tupper, Messrs. Whitney, Foster and Reid.

The town was decorated with bunting for the occasion.

CUSTOMS RECEIPTS.
Ottawa, Oct. 31.—The customs revenue of the Dominion for the month ending to-day shows a big increase over the same period last year. There is nearly half a million dollars of an increase. The figures are—\$2,460,019 for October, 1898, as against \$1,993,271 for October, 1897, or an increase of \$466,748.

LORD MINTO ON THE WAR.
Montreal, Que., Oct. 31.—The Governor-General, the Earl of Minto, attended an entertainment given by the Montreal Canadian Society to-night. His Excellency was presented with an address, and made a brief reply, in which he referred to the war in the Transvaal. He said that the news which had just been received was not encouraging, but he did not think it should be called a disaster, as he felt sure it would be retrieved, and that the army would be spurred to greater action. His Excellency also paid a high tribute to Gen. White, who he said was a splendid officer. The Governor-General's remarks were received with great enthusiasm.
