WHEREAS, it has been represented to us that criain persons within our Dominion of Canada, and without our License, are preparing or fitting out a naval or military expedition against the Dominions of His Majesty the King of Spain, to wit, against the Island of Cuba. And whereas we are on terms of friendship and amicable intercorse with His said Majesty, and with his several subjects and others inhabiting within the Countries, Territories, or Dominions of His Majesty, and whereas in and by a certain Act of the Parilament of our United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, made and passed in the Session thereof, held in the thirty-third and thirty-fourth year of Our Hulga, and known as "The Foreign Edistment Act, 1870," it is amongst other things declared and enacted as follows:


