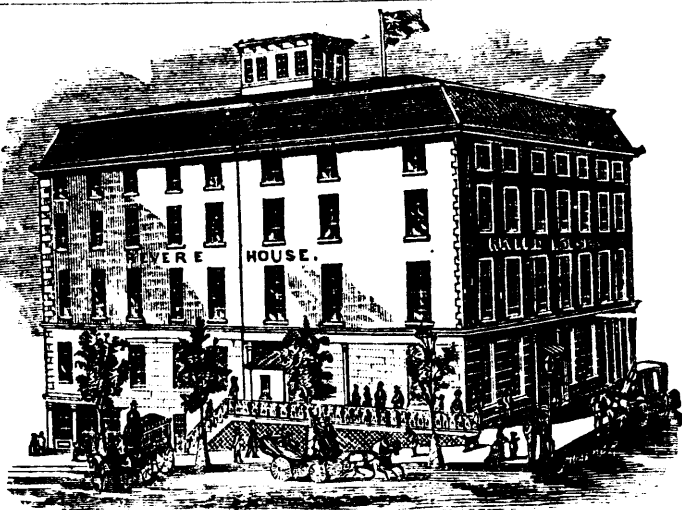
The HOUSE contains a FIRST-CLASS

The situation is the most delightful imaginable, in full view of the river and Thousand Islands, and a few hundred feet from the magnificent St. Lawrence. Brockville is the terminus for the Railway to the Upper Ottawa Valley which presents so many attractions to the tourist and whereby he has access to the finest hunting and fishing districts on this Continent. Fifteen miles in the interior is the wonderfully beautiful Charleston Lake, famous for its romantic features and its fishing grounds, which literally swarm with all kinds of fish. The Thousand Islands of the St. Lawrence commence at Brockville, and the facilities for boating and fishing on its waters are excellent. Buses to and from the Boats and Railways.
