Opera

Opera was a late blooming art form in Canada. The Canadian Opera Company is celebrating its 25th season this year. In 1972, l'Opéra du Québec was formed.

Ballet

Film

Canada's film industry has been noted for its documentary productions by the National Film Board, a government agency. The NFB has earned more than 1,200 international awards since its creation in 1939.

Popular films by and about Canadians include: *Nobody Waved Goodbye*, *Goin' Down the Road*, *Mon Oncle Antoine*, *The Rowdyman*, *Act of the Heart*, *Wedding in White*.

Sculpture

Like painting, the earliest Canadian sculpture of the colonists was intended primarily for Church decoration. In the 1800's, wood was the usual medium and the most famous names in wood-carving were those of the Levasseur, Baillargé and Hébert families.
