## THE CANADA-EC FISHERIES AGREEMENT IS AMENDED

The Canada-EC Long Term Agreement on Fisheries was amended on 1 January 1984 by an exchange of letters between Ambassador Jacques Gignac of the Canadian Mission to the EC on the one hand, and Director-General Eamonn Gallagher of the Commission and French Permanent Representative Jacques Leprette for the Council on the other. The Agreement, originally signed in 1981 and running until 1987, forms a key element of the Canada/EC bilateral relationship. It sets out terms and conditions for the import of Canadian fish products into the Community and for the access by Community fishermen to Canadian waters. The recent amendments are intended to bring clarification to these terms and conditions.
