Mr. Watson, from the Standing Committee on Indian Affairs and Northern Development, presented the Sixth Report of the said Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Thursday, May 14, 1970, your Committee has considered Bill C-212, An Act to amend the Yukon Act, the Northwest Territories Act and the Territorial Lands Act, and has agreed to report it with the following amendments:

Clause 2:

Add immediately following the word 'may' in line 12, of page 1, the words "after consultation with the Council".

Clause 4:

Strike out lines 8 to 18, both inclusive, on page 2, and substitute the following therefor:

"(2) Notwithstanding anything in the Canada Elections Act, if an election of members of the Council of the Yukon Territory is held in the year 1970

- (a) before the month of December, the age qualifications of persons as electors at such an election shall be those established pursuant to section 14 of the Yukon Act, as amended by this section, and in force on the day that the writs of election are issued; or
- (b) after the month of November, the qualifications of persons as electors and the qualifications of electors to vote at such an election shall be those established pursuant to section 14 of the Yukon Act, as amended by this section, and in force on the day that the writs of election are issued".
