## Interest rates

The average interest rate on the government's unmatured debt as at March 31, 1973 is estimated at 6.06 per cent compared with 5.89 per cent at March 31, 1972. The

average yield on three-month treasury bills was 4.46 per cent at tender on March 29, 1973 compared with 3.57 per cent at tender on March 29, 1972; on six-month bills it was 4.79 per cent at tender on March 29, 1973 compared with 3.86 per cent at tender on March 29, 1972; and on special bills it was 4.77 per cent at tender on February 8, 1973 compared with 4.39 per cent on February 10, 1972.
