

The Principal of McGill University today made the interesting announcement that beginning with the session 1927-1928 four additional scholarships would be available to students in the Medical School. Each scholarship has an annual value of \$400. and is tenable for five years. These scholarships are given for the purpose of attracting students who through lack of means would be unable to take advantage of the course at McGill University. Candidates will be required to present credentials of sufficient scholarship and promise to make them worthy of consideration for such a scholarship. The University reserves to itself the right of withholding the benefits should the holder at any time disclose that he was not worthy of the consideration granted.

Dean Martin with the co-operation of four valued friends of the University was instrumental in providing these scholarships.
