ARTICLE III.

MEMBERS.

1. The Society shall consist of Ordi-

nary and of Life Members.

2. Any Catholic is entitled to become an ordinary member upon payment in advance of the annual fee of \$2.00, or such other sum as may be fixed by the Society.

3. Any Catholic is entitled to become a Life Member upon payment of

a fee of \$25.00

4. Every member shall be entitled to receive one dollars' worth of the Society's publications each year free, and have the right of purchase at reduced rates.

ARTICLE IV.

MEETINGS.
