

ARTICLE XIII.—AMENDMENTS.

SEC. 1.—No part of this Constitution shall be amended, altered, annulled, or suspended, nor shall any addition be made thereto, except at the Annual Session, and in the manner hereinafter provided.

SEC. 2.—A proposition to amend this Constitution shall be recommended by a majority of the votes of the Representatives present, constituting a quorum of the Grand Temple. The amendment proposed shall be referred to a Committee of three, who shall report thereon at the present session, and the Grand Temple may consider the same; but no amendment shall be made to this Constitution except by a two-third vote, as provided in Article VIII of this Constitution.
