FOREIGN NEWS.

HOLLAND .- FLOSHING, APRIL 5.

This morning acrived from Cadsand a battalion of French infantry of the 8th Half-Brigade, which ammediately proceeded on its march for Middelburg. In the afternoon arrived another battalion of the same Brigade, which likewise proceeded for Middelburg: A battalion of 95th Half-Brigade, lying here in garrison, fee out at noon for Veere, and a few hours after was replaced by another battalion of the fame Brigade. Our garrison confitted hitherto of two battalions of the 95th Half-Brigade.

This evening, at fix o'clock, the whole garrifon came under arms in the Great Market, and Gex-ral Monnet, Commander of the troops in the town of Flushing and the Ille of Wolcheren, accompanied by General Often and fome other officers, apprared in the front, and delivered to the Commandant of the place a writing, which was read by the fame Commundant, and contained as fallows:

LIBERTY EQUALITY. Extract from the Register of the Deliverations of the Consuls of the Republic.

Paris, 10th of Germinal, 11th Year of the Republic.

Bonaparte, First Conful of the Republic, decrees : Art. 1: The Town of Flushing is placed in a flate of flege, under the command of the General of Brigade Monnet, who for this purpose is invested with all the necessary powers, and who will correspond directly with the Minister at Wat-

Art. v. The Minister at War is charged with the execution of the prefent Decrue.

The First Conful (Signed) BONAPARTE. The Secretary of State, (Signed) HUGHES B. MARET, The Minister at War, (Signed) ALEX. BERTHIER.
