NO WINNER AND NO LOSER AGREEMENT A GUARANTEE

Lord Fitzmaurice's Summing-Up of Result of Algeciras Conference.

London, April 6.—In the house of lords to-day, replying to a question regarding the Moroccan conference, the under secretary, Lord Edmund Fitzmaurice, said that the signing of the protocol would occur at an early date, if not to-morrow.

He added that when the papers were laid on the table in the house he thought the members would agree that the phrase, frequently used, that there had been "neither victors nor vanquished," expressed the true situation. The agreement, the under secretary added, was a further guarantee of the maintenance of harmonious action of the present powers, and a valuable step in the process of the restoration to the southern shores of the Mediterranean of civilization and order.

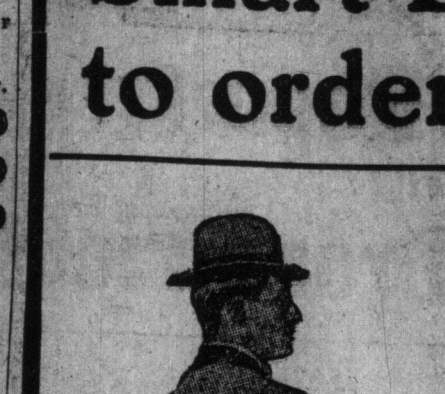
