A Dainty Corset Cover.
An immense concourse of people surrounded the armories and lined both sides of Queen's-avenue on Saturday afternoon on the occasion of the military funeral of Brevet Lieut.-Col. Henderson of the 48th Highlanders. All the imposing and stately accompaniments of a military funeral were present in the last splendid spectacle in which the late officer was himself a living actor. At 3 o'clock the remains were brought from the family residence, where a private service had been conducted by Rev. A. Logan Gaggie, besides the chief mourners, Mrs. Henderson and her daughter Lilian, who were present.

At the armories the casket reposed in the centre of the hall building. Drawn up in line were a firing party of the 48th, 150 strong. The band was stationed to the east and the pipers to the west. A group of officers, relatives and immediate friends were gathered near the coffin, the general public being excluded.

Before the brief service began the soldiers were formed up on three sides of a square around the coffin.

Rev. Mr. Gaggie read portions of the 80th Psalm, the 139th and the 137th. Only broken phrases of the familiar sentences could be heard. "Lord, make me to know mine end, and the measure of my days, that I may know how frail I am." "I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope."

After this, at a signal from Col. Robertson, who stood beside the minister, in full regimentals, the band played in very slow time, "Nearer My God, to Thee." The effect in the empty armory with the dull reverberation of the muted drums, was very impressive. A prayer followed by Rev. Mr. Gaggie, and the casket was borne to the hearse. THRILLING DEATH TALE

Greenland Expedition Which Discovered New Land and Named it for Danish King

BERGEN, Norway, Aug. 16.—The ship Denmark of the Denmark-Greenland expedition has arrived at Bergen, Norway. The body of the Danish explorer, Mylius Eriksen, who perished in a storm while traveling over the ice on the northeastern coast of Greenland, was not recovered.

Lieut. Frolle, master of the Denmark, made the following statement to the Associated Press:

"The Denmark-Greenland expedition carried out the objects for which it was formed, but it paid dearly in having one of its men, Mylius Eriksen, its leader, and Lieut. Hagen and Broenlund perished in November, 1907, in trying to reach the north coast of Greenland by way of the inland sea, having been obliged to remain on the north coast during the summer of that year, owing to the state of the weather.

"Broenlund's body was found in a crevice near a depot. Beside it were sketches showing the work that had been accomplished, and also his diary, in which was the following entry: 'Perished at 79 degrees under a trial return to the north coast of Greenland. Arrived here under a decreasing moon and cannot go on owing to frozen rest and darkness. The corpses of the others are in the middle of the fjord. Hagen died Nov. 15 and Mylius ten days later. (Signed) Joergen Broenlund.'

"Broenlund was buried on the spot where his body was found. It proved impossible to find the corpses of the others owing to the heavy snowfall.
