After some debate, both the motion and the amendmen TIFTH R. were, by permission of the Synod, withdrawn.

Moved by Rev. L. G. Stevens, seconded by Rev. R. M. E. wards.

Resolved, That this Synod, before which matters of so gran and delicate a nature have been brought, bear witness of or high appreciation of the dignity, the candour, the patient and the impartiality which have characterized His Lordshin bearing and utterances in presiding; our renewed love a respect for His Lordship; our wish and prayer that he m long be spared to us; and our earnest thanks to Almight God that the deliberations of this Synod have been so en nently free from the spirit of bitterness and party stri happily issuing in that harmony which comes from acting " the unity of the Spirit and in the bond of peace." unanimously by a standing vote.
