AUCTIONS

LONDON, Sept. 9—Harold J. Dartnall, a naval architect, of Southampton, has invented a submarine investigator, a form of craft similar to a submarine. It is, however, much smaller, and can be constructed at a small cost.

It possesses the power to run on the surface, to dive to any desired depth, and run level there, and return to the surface at will.

The necessary illumination for seeing objects at such depths will be provided by powerful electric lights on the outside of the "investigator." One for examining the suitability of the sea floor for resting will, of course, be inside, and show through the glass observation floor at the bottom of the vessel.
