IOLTER DIES TODAY FOR THE

MURDER OF RUTH WHEELER

Ossington, N. Y., Jan. 29—Albert Wolter was put to death in the electric chair at Sing Sing prison at 5.41 o'clock for he murder of fifteen year old Ruth Wheeler nearly two years ago.

The girl went to Wolter's flat in New York in search of employment, and he killed her, after she had been mistreated. Wolter left a statement with Warden Kennedy, denying that he had committed the crime.

The state electrician said that Wolter wed less resistance to the electric curnt, than any murderer put to death by lectricity at Sing Sing prison.
