THE HOUSE MOURNS.

Sympathy Expressed With Dr. Borden on Death of His Son.

THE HOUSE IN CONCURRENCE.

The Criminal Code—The Amendment Regarding False Pretences Concerned in—The Election Act Amendments—Mr. Mulock's Resolution Regarding the Suppression of Swearing.

Ottawa, July 18.—The House of Commons closed the session last night in sorrow for the death of Lieut. Borden. After a wearisome day in concurrence, the Premier at 10 o'clock in moving the adjournment, confirmed the rumor of his death, speaking with deep sympathy for his colleague.

Mr. Davin, who was leading the Opposition, voiced the grief of his fellow-Conservatives.

Sir Alfred Laurier made the following reference to the death of Lieut. Borden. Before this motion to adjourn the House is put I am sure the House will agree that I may properly take this opportunity of expressing the grief which has been circulated through the corridors of the House this afternoon to the effect that Lieut. Borden, son of the Minister of Militia and Defence, met his death yesterday in South Africa. This afternoon His Excellency received a telegram from Lord Roberts informing him that yesterday at Pretoria Lieut. Borden was killed in action. Lieut. Borden was a young man, who enlisted recently to fight for the Queen in South Africa. He was only 23 years of age, a young man of great promise, an able figure, bright, intelligent, a model boy in every way. He had, as I am informed, already made a mark in his career, attracting the attention of his chief by his coolness, courage, and his daring, by his courage, and had won the affection of his comrades by his amiable disposition. This precious life has been cut short by the uncertainties of war. Now this evening, I am sure, will reach the heart of every member of this House.

He is the son of a prominent manager of this Administration, an old member of this House, and a popular member, and as I am reminded the only son. Whatever bitterness there may be of strife, I am sure that before the uncertainties of war, his father's sternness disappears, and that on both sides of the House friends and foes will unite in honoring the bereaved father and the bereaved mother that grief which can be the only solace of such a misfortune on this side of the grave.
