Moreover, the Governors in their own monthly meetings, never proceed to business without first imploring the Divine assistance and blessing. Hoping for the continuance of that blessing in the future, as in the past, they commend the Institution to the prayers and the support, of all who desire to see sound Education and true Religion flourish in our land.
