ADDRESS BY PRESIDENT OF ST. JOHN BOARD OF TRADE TO VISITING EDITORS OF CANADA

EXPORT TRAFFIC AT WINTER PORT. The completion of the Canadian Pacific Railway from ocean to ocean in 1889, and the cancelling in 1897 of Canadian government subsidies paid by the running to Portland, Maine, were the chief factors which led up to the winter port.
