Dozen Americans to Try to Rescue Two Comra from Tribesmen.

Washington, Nov. 18.—Urgs, the Mangoitan city famous as the home of "The Living Buddha," is the centre of an outbreak which, according to official advices, hus reached serious proportions, the lives of foreigners, among them two Americans, being in danger. The two Americans are named Mills and McLauphin, both of them in the amploy of the Mongolian Trading Company.

The uprising in Urga is the result of a combined attack on the city by Russians, Buriats and Mongois. Urgs is the capital of Outer Mongolia. According to State Department advices, Chinese soldiers were reported to be locting Russian residences in Urga. The telegraph wires have been cut and the city is now without means of communication with the outside world.
