church the number of members removed by death has been smaller than usual. We know that we voice the mind of the congregation when we extend our sympathy to all who have suffered on account of the death of loved ones.

A Junior Christian Endeavor Society has been organized and is doing an excellent work among the young people. While not enumerating the different organizations, we are glad to commend the work which all have done during the year which has so recently closed.
