CHAP. H.

An ORDINANCE

For further continuing an Ordinance made the ninth day of March in the twentieth year of his Majesty's Reign, intitled, "An Ordinance for the regulation and establishment of fees.

titled, "An ordinance for the regulation and establishment of sees," and every article and clause therein contained, shall be and continue, and the same is hereby further continued, from the passing of this present ordinance, unto the thirtieth day of April, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty-seven.

Ordained and enacted by the authority aforefaid, and passed in council, under the public seal of the province, at the council-chamber, in the castle of St. Lewis, in the city of Quebec, the twentieth day of February, in the twenty-sixth year of the reign of our sovereign lord GEORGE the third, by the grace of God, of Great-Britain, France, and Ireland, king, defender of the faith, and so forth, and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty-fix.
