BILL.

An Act to amend the Act to modify the Usury Laws.

In amendment of the Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in Preamble. the sixteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled : "An Act to mo-"dify the Usury Laws," Her Majesty, by and with the advice and 5 consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :---

I. For and notwithstanding any thing in the third section of the said No contract to be void by reason Act contained, no contract made or security given after the passing of or excess of inthis Act, in any part of this Province, shall be void either for the whole made payable. 10 or in part by reason of any excess of interest thereby made payable above

10 or in part by reason of any excess of interest interest made payable above the rate of six pounds for the forbearance of one hundred pounds for a year; and the said rate of interest, or such higher or lower rate of interest as may have been agreed upon, shall be allowed and recovered in all cases where it shall be the agreement of the parties that interest shall be 15 paid.

II. Nothing in this Act shall be construed to apply to any Bank or Act not to extend to Banks or Banking Institution, or to any Insurance Company, or to any Corporation other or Association of persons heretofore authorized by Law to lend or borrow money.
