BILL.

**An Act to allow a Grant of the Hospital Reserve,
Belleville, to the Town Council.**

WHEREAS in the original Survey of the Town of Belleville, Lots number thirty-two and thirty-three on the East side of Church Street and thirty-two and thirty-three on the West side of Rear Street in the said Town were set 5 apart and reserved for the purpose of a Public Hospital: and whereas it appears from the representation of the Town Council of the said Town that the said land is not suited for the purpose for which it was so designed. Preamble.

Be it therefore enacted &c., That so soon as the said Town Council shall have made other suitable provision for a public Hospital in the said Town, to the satisfaction of the Governor General of this Province or the person administering the Government thereof, it shall and may be lawful for Her Majesty Her Heirs or Successors to grant to the Town Council of the Town of Belleville all and singular the said land and premises with the appurtenances to hold to the said Town Council in fee simple for the uses of the said Town of Belleville. Power given to Her Majesty to grant the Hospital Reserve in Belleville to the Town Council.
