Inspectors.

Sec. 63. Inspectors must make monthly returns to the Minister of Agriculture of every inspection made by them.

Cleansing Cars.

Sec. 64. No animals are to be allowed to be placed on board cars till the litter from the previous load has been removed and the car whitewashed with time and carbolic acid, 1 pound commercial carbolic acid to 5 gallons of lime wash. Shippers may object to place their animals on uncleaned cars, and may lodge a complaint with the nearest Inspector, who will cause such cars to be cleansed as above at the exexpense of the railway company, or prohibit their use till this regulation is complied with.
