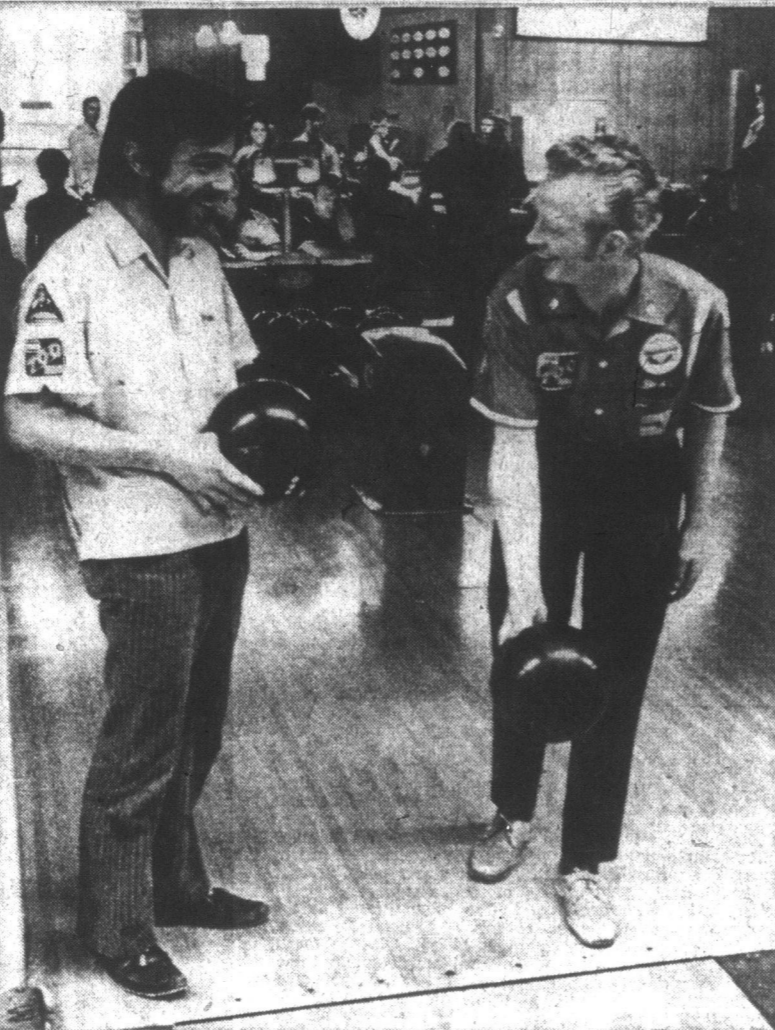

## Des Thompson becomes second local man in two weeks to bowl perfect '300' game

APPLEWOOD — Des Thompson, in the five short years he has been bowling since moving to Mississauga from Coventry, England, has established himself as one of the premier 10-pin bowlers in the area.

He had come close to a perfect game several times with such juicy items as eight strikes in a row but never had hit the elusive "300" game — that is, until last Wednesday night.

In the space of two weeks, the incredible happened again. Thompson sandwiched his 300-mark in between marks of 265 and 238 to duplicate Brian McClelland's feat

of two weeks ago. McClelland was bowling in the Suburban Majors league while Thompson, who bowls in four leagues, turned in his feat during the Wednesday Night Mixed League at the same Brunswick-Applewood Lanes in the Applewood Village Shopping Centre.

In the process, he became one of the few Canadians to ever roll an 800 series and the third bowler this year in the Toronto area to bowl 300. McClelland had been the first to roll a 300 in the 10-year history of the lanes.

His feat came on the numbers three and four lanes before a wildly enthusiastic crowd of supporters. Thompson has a superb 190 average in three of the four leagues he bowls.

For his efforts, the 36-year-old father of five is in line for several honors including a cheque for \$300 from Brunswick of Canada, Ltd.
