

- Q. Near what river is Moose Point? A. Moon River.
- Q. Near the mouth? A. Yes.
- Q. Have you been to Moon River? A. Not there.
- Q. But near there, to Moose Point? A. Yes.
- Q. With other Indians from Christian Island? A. Yes.
- Q. Quite a large party, a number of you? A. Yes.
- Q. Several of you men together? A. Well the time I mean I was with my mother and sisters selling baskets and fancy work.
- Q. Did you go only the once? A. No, every year.
- Q. Were you along the shore on the east side of Georgian Bay any time except in summer? Were you up there fishing in the Fall? A. The east side of Georgian Bay?
- Q. You said you were up to Moose Deer Point? A. Yes.
- Q. And some of the men of your party would be hunting?
- A. I never been there in the hunting season.
- Q. Have you ever been up Moose Point, say, when any of the party were doing any hunting? A. No.
- Q. They did some fishing of course all up through there?
- A. Not to my knowledge.
- Q. But you fished yourself? A. Round Christian Island.
- Q. And when you went to Moose Point you did some fishing?
- A. Trolling along.
- Q. Along the shore all the way up? A. Yes.
- Q. And you would camp on an island as you went, wherever it suited you? A. Yes.
- Q. And you'd fish a bit? A. Yes.
- Q. And all the Indians up there fish off any island in Georgian Bay that it suits them, don't they? A. Not now. We pay a license around our island to fish.
- Q. To the Government? A. Yes.
- Q. You even have to have a license for guiding? A. Yes.
