

Macdowell & Larrieu have confounded the Privy Council with the Cabinet Council we hold that our act is the same as Eng in this respect.

The Minister of Justice with no like Lord Chancellor in Eng. is responsible for administration of justice. On his advice judges are appointed. — Until recently (1891) we had no ministers outside the Cabinet. Recently the office of Minister of Inland Rev. & Minister of Customs has been abolished & office of Minister of Customs take their place. & offices of Controller of Inland Rev. & Customs have been established as ^{separate} pot. offices outside the Cabinet. It remains to be seen whether this copy of the Eng Const. will be successful. — In Eng we have the political or deputy heads — under secretaries or secretaries of ministers. These men are trained to be ministers of crown. The conditions of society in this country makes it doubtful whether this system of under Secys will be of use to Canada.
