I beg to inform you that a Petition has been received from Mr. Anthony Sacobie residing on the St. Mary's Reserve, on the River St. John, asking that one Stephen Nash, whose Father was a White Man, and whose Mother was a Squaw, and who is now residing on the St. Mary's Reserve, be removed from the said Reserve, and I have to ask you to be good enough to look into this matter at your early convenience, and favour the Department with a full report thereon.

I may say that a Permit was granted George Nash and his family in 1896, to reside on this Reserve.
