Sir:-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 26th instant, enclosing cheque for the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, being first instalment of purchase price of land at Sturgeon Falls on the Nipissing Indian Reserve.

In compliance with your request, a sale of the land in question being 6400 acres situate at Sturgeon Falls, in The Nipissing Indian Reserve, recently surrendered by the Indians has been entered in the name of the Occidental Syndicate Limited, the purchase price, being \$10,000 and the terms of payment one quarter cash and the balance in three equal annual instalments with interest at 6 per cent, subject to a reservation of 5 per cent for road purposes.
