TO HIS HONOUR

THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:

The undersigned has the honour to REPORT:

THAT the GREEN ROAD was established as a highway thirty-three feet wide by Notice in the Gazette of May 23rd, 1929;

AND THAT it was subsequently ascertained that the consent of the Department of Indian Affairs, Ottawa, through whose reserve the establishment of the highway had been made, had not been obtained owing to some misunderstanding;

AND THAT the Minister of Public Works has by notice published in the B.C. Gazette discontinued and closed the said Green Road established in the Gazette May 23rd 1929;

AND THAT by virtue of Section 11 of the "Highway Act" Chapter 103 of the "Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1924" the Minister of Public Works is empowered under the authority of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to transfer the land comprised in such highway, so discontinued and closed, to the owner of the land of which it originally formed part;

AND THAT no objection has been filed with the Minister of Public Works in response to advertisement in the Ashcroft "Journal" of the intention to discontinue and close said Green Road;

AND THAT the said Minister has agreed to transfer the land contained in the said Green Road to His Majesty the King, as represented by the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs, Ottawa, for the consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00).

AND TO RECOMMEND that in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) the land contained in the said Green Road be conveyed to His Majesty the King, as represented by the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs, Ottawa.

AND THAT a certified copy of this order, if approved, be forwarded to the Registrar of Titles at Kamloops, B.C. to be accepted by him as a full and complete conveyance of the lands herein described, without further formal instrument of transfer or conveyance.
