Answer - Yes, sir.

Question - Also that Ptes. LANTHIER and PAISLEY were looking for a fight?

Answer - Yes, Sir.

Question - Did either LANTHIER or PAISLEY strike any blows?

Answer - I did not see them strike any blows.

Question - What were LANTHIER and PAISLEY doing?

Answer - They appeared to be standing by ready to prevent any interference. They were also fighting shouting.

Question - Previously, you gave evidence on this case under oath. Then, you made reference to three or four actually delivering blows. Why do you change the story?

Answer - I am not certain to what extent the others were implicated since I cannot swear to having seen anyone but LSE strike any blows.
