


The one way fare from Vancouver to Kincolith at the mouth of the Naas River is \$39.81. You can take 150 lbs. baggage free, balance will be charged for at standard rates.

If you are the outdoor type, you will enjoy Aiyansh. It has a modern school building and the people are a fairly good class of Indian.

Actually, if you were not keen on batching, you could get one or two meals per day at the Mission House where Mrs. Kinley, the Rector's wife, is a grand cook and would be willing to have you at a fair rate. I have talked with her today and she will do what she can to help in any way. She and Mr. Kinley will be your neighbors, in any case and they are fine people. If you took your lunch and evening meal with them, you would only have to worry about breakfasts. Be sure and let me know the date you plan to leave Vancouver. Get your reservation in early as boats are well booked up.
