A thirty-one head of Holstein dairy cattle, which reached Auckland yesterday from the ship, the steamer Cairnross. Included in the consignment were several calves, nine being born on the voyage, and which two died. All are pedigree stock, their value approaching £3,000. The animals will have to go into quarantine for some time, the necessary arrangements having been made by the Government. The officers of the Government Stock Department, Mr. Meekes expressed the opinion that the animals were a good lot, although naturally somewhat out of condition after their long voyage.
