by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, that-

1. From and out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of \$7,502,874 04 Canada, there shall and may be applied a sum not exceeding appropriated for certain in the whole seven million, five hundred and two thousand, expenses in eight hundred and seventy-four dollars and four cents, towards 1867-8. defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service of the Dominion, from the first day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, to the thirtieth day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, not otherwise provided for, and set forth in the Schedule A to this Act, and for the other purposes in the said Schedule mentioned.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of \$7,901,855 01 Canada, there shall and may be paid and applied a sum not appropriated for certain exceeding in the whole seven million, nine hundred and one expenses in thousand, eight hundred and fifty-five dollars and one cent, 1868-9. towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service of the Dominion, from the first day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixtyeight, to the thirtieth day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, not otherwise provided for, and set forth in the Schedule B to this Act, and for the other purposes in the said Schedule mentioned.

3. The amount of such sums of money as may have been Any balance paid in the present financial year 1867-8, for or on account of remaining of vote of credit any of the services mentioned in Schedule A to this Act, out under 31 Vic. of the sum of five millions, two hundred and sixty-four thousand, two hundred and seventy-nine dollars, granted by Parsolidated Reversions. liament, by the Act passed in the present Session, chapter four, nue Fund. towards defraying the expenses of the Public Service of the Dominion, not otherwise provided for, from the first day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, to the thirty-first day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, shall be charged as having been paid out of the sums granted for such services by this Act, and any balance of the said grant, after deducting the amount so expended and accounted for in the Public Accounts laid before the House of Commons, as provided in the said Act, up to the day last aforesaid, shall be cancelled and returned to the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

4. The Governor in Council may authorize the raising of a Governor in sum of money not exceeding six million dollars, upon the credit of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Canada, and to be raising of a charge upon the same, but subject to the several preferential money on the payments by the British North America Act, 1867, and by the Consolidated first section of the Act of the Parliament of Canada, passed in the present Session, and intituled: An Act respecting the Consolidated selection of \$6,000,000. solidated Revenue Fund, charged on the Consolidated Revenue
