An Act to Enable Proprietors of Lands, to Affess and Discharge the Expence, which has Accrued upon Dividing their Lands, by Virtue of a Former Law of this Province.

Tap 5. HERE AS by an AS of this Province, Institel, An Act of the Special of the Common and Under aid, Sundry Proprietors of Lands within this Province, have Proceeded to a Division under the Sanction of whereas Confiderable Expence has attended the making such Division.

Be it Enabled, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council, and Assembly, That all Persons, Proprietors of Lands within this Province, who by Virtue of an Act, Intitled, An Act to Enable Proprietors to Divide their Lands, beld in Common and Undivided, have helectors by a Associate their Lands, beld in Common and divided their Lands, under the Sanction, and agreeable to the Directions of the said recited Act which and every such Proprietor, shall pay their dividend or proportional Part of all such Expence, as may have arisen from the making such Division.

And be it further Enacted, That all Accounts of Expences Incurr'd for the Services aforefaid, shall before Payment, he laid before the Justices of the Peace for each County, in the Quarter Sessions; who are hereby Impowered to appoint proper Persons, to audit said Accounts, and to make a dividend to each Right or Share of Land in such Propriety, in just and equal Proportion; which dividend or Proportion, when approved of isympthe said Court of Quarter Sessions, shall be paid by each Proprietor or Person in possession of such Sands, to the Person or Persons to be appointed by the Propriety to receive the same; and if any Proprietor or other Person in possession of any Right, or Share of Land, divided as aforesaid, shall Ressue or Neglect to pay His, Her, or their respective Dividend, or Proportion as aforesaid, it shall and may be Lawful, on Complaint of such Receiver appointed as asoresaid, so any one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace, to issue a Warrant-of Divires and Sale of the Delinquents Goods and Chattels, for the Receiver or the same, with the Charges of Prosecution.

And be it further Enacted, That if any proprietors of Lands, divided as aforefaid, be ablent, and no Person appearing in their Behalf, or shall be present
