British Empire Exhibition.

Present arrangements provide that the British Empire Exhibition shall be held during the months of April to November in 1924, at Wembley Park, in the northwestern district of London, England. The general scheme for this exhibition, which was originally put forward by the late Lord Strathcona in 1913, and held over owing to the war, was definitely launched in June 1920, with the Prince of Wales as chairman. The date was first set for 1923, but later it was changed to 1924.


