## Action of Mexican Government a Breach of International Courtesies

### U.S. Officials Make a Big Seizure of Drugs

#### —Military Demonstration on the Occasion of Unveiling Potsdam Memorial.

**BREACH OF INTERNATIONAL COURTESIES.** LONDON, June 16. Prime Minister MacDonald stated in the House of Commons to-day that the British Government regard the action of the Mexican Government, against Herbert Cummins, British Agent in Mexico, as a grave breach of international courtesies. The Premier said he had informed the Mexican Government that in the event of its taking steps against Mr. Cummins, in which Great Britain did not concur, the mission of Sir Thomas Horler to Mexico would not be proceeded with.

**EX CROWN PRINCE TAKES SALUTE** BERLIN, June 16. The unveiling at Potsdam yesterday of a memorial to the 6,000 officers and men of the first regiment of Foot Guards, who fell in the War, was made the occasion for a striking demonstration. It was attended by the former German Crown Prince, Frederick William, and Prince Eitel Frederick, and numerous other princes and generals and officers of the regiment.

**DRAWES LARGE AUDIENCE TO MAJESTIC THEATRE.**

"The Stranger of the North," is an interesting picture because it is an unusual one. There are several reasons for this. How he becomes MacGregor's mainstay and how he saves Mary of her folly—this is the story.
