WILL NOT RECOMMEND CHANGE IN TEACHERS

Principal Miller of Central Collegiate Gives Intimation As To Policy To Be Pursued.

At a meeting of the Collegiate Committee of the Board of Education to be held this week, various questions concerning the Central Collegiate will be considered in detail. Mr. Miller, the new principal, has already stated that he will not recommend any changes in the teaching staff at the beginning of the term, and any new teachers who may appear at the opening would only be those who are required by reason of new classes being added to the ordinary curriculum of the school work.

Whether the old Princess Avenue Building will be used to form the nucleus of an East London Collegiate will also be discussed. This was a problem that was debated in Toronto before the department of education by the delegation from the local board.

CYCLONE DEVASTATES THE GUELPH DISTRICT

Roofs Are Lifted Off Buildings and Trains Are Much Delayed.

Guelph, June 26.—A disastrous cyclone visited Wellington County Sunday night.

The cyclone swept down from north Fergus district.
Roofs were lifted off buildings, and of Kitchener and west through the trains from Stratford and Palmerston were delayed. One building at Guelph had its roof lifted off the railway tracks fully 50 yards away, delaying trains for more than an hour. A number of farm houses near Fergus are on fire, while others have been ravaged by the cyclone.

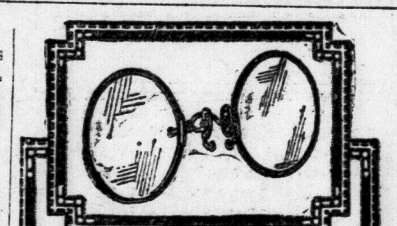

APPLY INTERNATIONAL LAW TO RADIO USE IN WARFARE

Associated Press Despatch.
Washington, June 26.—Application of recognized principles of international law to the use of radio and aircraft in warfare is shown through the publication of the text of its general report to have been the aim of the commission of jurists which met at The Hague in December to formulate rules to lay before the various powers.

The practicability of the proposals rather than purely idealistic motives, it is pointed out, also was considered carefully by the commission, which was composed of representatives of the United States, Great Britain, Italy, Japan and Holland.
The course to be taken in the effort to have the 12 articles dealing with radio and the sixty affecting aircraft written into international law by official sanction of governments has not been determined.
