## TORONTO TO SEE ALL THREE FINALS

Queen's String of Seventeen Straight Wins Dates Back To 1922.

Toronto, Nov. 12.—The decision of Queen's University to play their semi-final game for the Canadian championship with Hamilton Tigers in Toronto means that local football fans will have the opportunity of seeing all three games of the Dominion playoffs without going away from home.
