**III. RESPONSIVE SENTENCES:** Psalm 19 : 7-9.

*Superintendent.* The law of the Lord is perfect converting the soul:

*Superintendent.* The statutes of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart:

*School.* The commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes.
